The volumes come with games and activities aimed at environmental education and awareness.

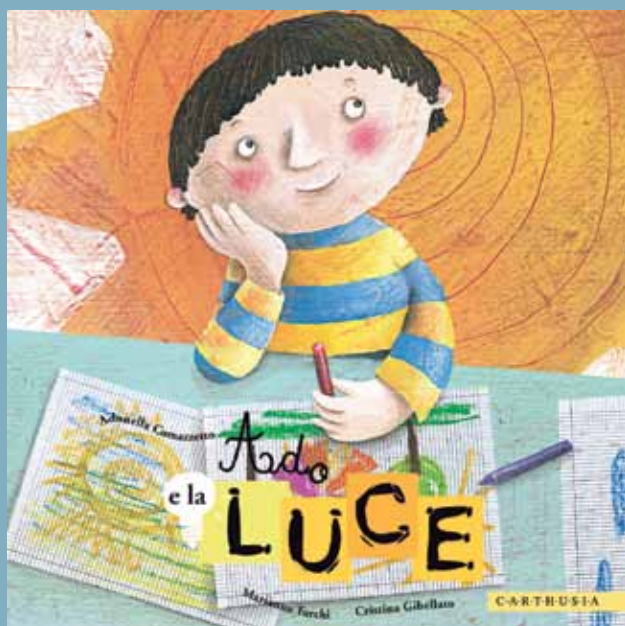
