Thanks to a little Kamishibai theatre accompanied with colourful illustrations by Emanuela Bussolati and the text of the story, you can follow the show, obviously in Piripù language: a universal language made up of voices, whispers and mumbles, for playing and creating complicity without age limits or understanding, because only the intonations, expressions and gestures matter.

This example, typical of the Japanese storytellers tradition where the narrator reads and speaks while the viewer watches and listens, becomes the ideal tool for the animation of a lively and entertaining read which can be done anywhere: at home, at school, in the library, in a playroom...
