THE BOOK

Following the great success of *'Kuta's invention'*, comes a new title dedicated to the history of the printing press, from its origins to today and beyond, with a look at the future and the prospects for the e-book. *What a revolution!* describes the invention of the printing press and the evolution of the book, both technically and in terms of the social and historical impact of this new "art form". The 8 historical chapters are introduced by 8 creative texts, each one in a different style (letter, nursery rhyme, science fiction story...), all involving a wide range of authors: two children's writers, a historian and eight illustrators.
