The bilingual Storiesconfinatate series collects together 22 stories that come from far-away countries with the twin objective of introducing Italian children to different worlds and cultures, and at the same time teaching foreign children the importance of respect for their own original culture.

The particular format allows the book to be read in two ways: on one side the pages turn just like a real illustrated storybook where the tale is told in two languages. On the other side, the whole story can be seen as one great big picture, which is 138 cms long. Inside the book, two pages give interesting facts and information about the country featured in the story.
